This will be the 7th year that I have held the Junior Billiken Basketball Camp on the campus of St. Louis University High School. My staff and I have the philosophy that the campers should enjoy themselves, be safe, and play hard, all while learning skills to make them a better basketball player. We also stress being a good teammate and a good camper.

The camp staff is comprised of coaches on staff at SLUH, along with high school and college coaches in the area. We will also have current and former players of SLUH along with alumni from other high schools. Some alumni are current college players.

There are many facets of camp. During stations, the players will work with our coaches in small groups on individual skill development. After lunch, there are talks from coaches or college players. There are competitions throughout the week, including a free throw contest, 1-on-1 tournament, Hot Shot competition, and 3 point contest. Finally, players will play games in the weeklong 5-on-5 league and the 3-on-3 tournament.

Monday through Thursday, the times are 8:30-3:00. On Friday, camp is dismissed at noon. Parents are invited to attend the awards ceremony begins at 11:30 on Friday. Several awards are given out, including the Most Valuable Camper and the Teammate Award.

We have changed our age range and are no longer accepting 3rd and 4th graders. We are also only accepting 120 campers per week.
