Congratulations on your acceptance to St. Louis University High School. Hopefully, the next four years will be both challenging and enjoyable for you.

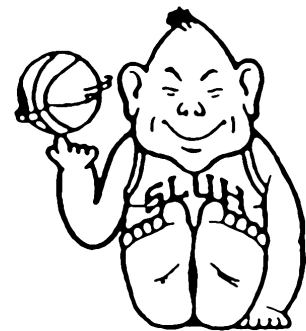
