About the Course

The SAT/ACT Prep Course is an intensive course devoted to covering all aspects of the new SAT and ACT tests, including test-taking skills, reading comprehension skills, vocabulary, and a review of concepts needed for content.

Full-length practice exams will be given for both the SAT and ACT, which will be analyzed to indicate specific areas of strengths and weaknesses for each student individually and for the class as a whole. The fee for this year's course is \$425.00, which includes all necessary materials.

About the Materials

All materials necessary for the course will be provided, including actual SAT and ACT tests from previous testing dates. The books used in the course are the only review books sanctioned by the College Board and the Educational Testing Service, the makers of the SAT and ACT tests. The experience of this course has shown that other preparation books and computer programs do not adequately represent the true content of these tests.
