# ACT PREP COURSE in preparation for the June 13, 2020 ACT test

### **About the Course**

The ACT Prep Course is an intensive course devoted to covering all aspects of the ACT test, including test-taking skills, reading comprehension skills, grammar/vocabulary, and a review of concepts needed for content.

Full-length practice exams will be given for the ACT test, which will be analyzed to indicate specific areas of strengths and weaknesses for each student individually and for the class as a whole. The course includes over twenty hours of instruction. The fee for this year's course is \$425.00, which includes all necessary materials. **Your cancelled check will serve as your receipt**. Classes will close when filled; please register early to reserve your place. An email will be sent during the week before the course begins with information about parking, classroom location, etc.

#### **About the Materials**

The books used in the course are the only review books sanctioned by the makers of the ACT test. Students are asked to order the textbook for the class. Instructions will given upon registration. The experience of this course has shown that other preparation books and computer programs do not adequately represent the true content of these tests.

#### **Schedule of Classes**

Note: This course is scheduled to begin on April 18/19 in preparation for the June ACT test. In accordance with city/county directives for the closure of schools, this class will begin online with a full-length baseline test that will be scored with personalized analysis given. The online instruction will include video lessons, book work, online quizzes, as well as opportunity to engage with the instructor directly through realtime question-and-answer explanations. The intention is to have the course transition to in-person instruction as soon as social distancing requirements are lifted.
