

HARRIERS FINISH SEASON

In the last two regular season meets of the year, the harriers continued the patterns they developed during the season with the B and C teams running impressively and the Varsity, despite an apparent overabundance of talent, struggling.

Last Friday, all three teams ran in a meet against two very tough teams, DeSmet and St. Mary's at DeSmet. Despite the margin of loss (63-22), the team ran well. Pete Palumbo finished first in the race with a time of 16:50 min. Krekeler, Gorzyca, Schukai and Althoff all finished under 21 min. with Krekeler at 19:03 min.

The B-team grabbed two places enroute to a second place finish behind DeSmet. Tom Whalen and Don Beckerle finished 2nd and 3rd respectively. The remainder of the team - Barhorst, Martin and Lundberg, all finished under 21 min.

C-team sensation Marty Hunnecke paced the team to a close second-place finish (29 - 28) behind DeSmet. Marty's time of 19:06 was good for first place. Reinecke finished second with 19:47 and Tom Buerkert placed fifth at 20:37.
