About the Course

The ACT Prep Course is an intensive course devoted to covering all aspects of the ACT test, including test-taking skills, reading comprehension skills, grammar/vocabulary, and a review of concepts needed for content.

Full-length practice exams will be given for the ACT test, which will be analyzed to indicate specific areas of strengths and weaknesses for each student individually and for the class as a whole. The course includes over twenty hours of instruction. The fee for this year's course is \$425.00, which includes all necessary materials. **Your cancelled check will serve as your receipt.** Classes will close when filled; please register early to reserve your place. An email will be sent during the week before the course begins with information about parking, classroom location, etc.

About the Materials

All materials necessary for the course will be provided, including actual ACT tests from previous testing dates. The books used in the course are the only review books sanctioned by the makers of the ACT test. The experience of this course has shown that other preparation books and computer programs do not adequately represent the true content of these tests.
