

# Security Camera and Server Updates

## *St. Louis University High School*

### STANDARD

Surveillance cameras are everywhere, and the vast majority of high schools nationwide (89% as of two years ago) have security cameras that record. Cameras are used, not just as a record of past events, but as a safety tool so you can remotely monitor all areas of the school from one location.

### CURRENT STATUS AT SLUH

St. Louis University High School currently has twenty five (25) security cameras operational, which record onto our own servers. Additionally, ten (10) cameras have been purchased this school year and have been installed, however we lack the server capacity to view them. There is no real-time center or employee that is dedicated to view the cameras.

### VISION

Over the next five (5) years, we envision doubling the number of cameras we currently have from thirty five (35) to seventy (70) and procuring enough server space to monitor them and store the data and information for at least fourteen (14) days. This will help us monitor our vast campus effortlessly, impact negative activity like vandalism or theft positively, and create a more secure system for students and visitors alike.
