

Safety and Security Drills for Students and Faculty

STANDARD

It is recommended that schools have twelve (12) safety and security drills a year, to include lockdown, lockout, evacuation, shelter in place, and tornado drills.

CURRENT STATUS AT SLUH

St. Louis University High School regularly conducts drills each year, during both semesters, and will increase the frequency moving forward.

VISION

SLUH currently conducts safety drills (fire, lockdown, earthquake/tornado) at the beginning of the school year and again during second semester. We envision conducting drills on a monthly basis beginning in the 2019-2020 school year. The following are the type of drills we will be doing:

- Fire
- Lock Down
- Lock Out
- Earthquake/tornado
- Evacuation
- Off-site Reunification

The St. Louis Fire Department and the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department will be contacted and requested to attend and assist with these training drills. A walk through of our property with the police SWAT team will allow them to have a better understanding of our campus and allow them to help point out vulnerabilities so we can address them before a disaster occurs.

We also will publish that drills have been conducted on the school website so parents and other community members will know the dates we conducted the drill after the drill's completion.
