Charlie Martel — Varsity Head Coach



Charlie Martel is a native of the St. Louis area. He attended St. Louis University High School and is a 1973 graduate. He was a member of the SLUH varsity soccer team both his junior and senior years. He participated in Coach Ebbie Dunn's first state championship season in 1973, as a midfielder. In 1973, the Junior Bills finished with a 23-2-1 record.

Coach Martel attended Thomas Aquinas College in Calabasas, California, and graduated with a BA in Liberal Arts in 1977. He then began a 34-year teaching career at several grade schools and Kapauon Mt. Carmel High School in Wichita, Kansas. He moved back to St. Louis in 1990 and taught one year at Vianney High School before earning a Masters Degree in Theological Studies in 1996 from Notre Dame University. Coach Martel came to SLUH in 1991, where he teaches Theology to Juniors and Seniors and coaches the varsity soccer team. He is in his 24th year at the helm of the Jr. Bills. Charlie and his wife Christina have three boys-Samuel, Isaac, and William. At SLUH he has 477 wins, 149 losses and 59 ties. Overall, Charlie has 487 wins, 170 losses and 61 ties.

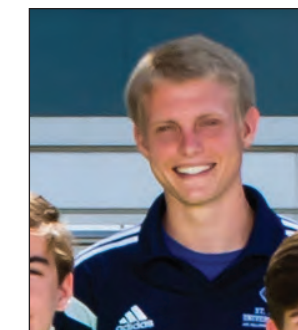
He is starting his 10th year teaching sophomores and seniors. In addition to his soccer duties he is now in his 13th year as assistant varsity baseball coach.

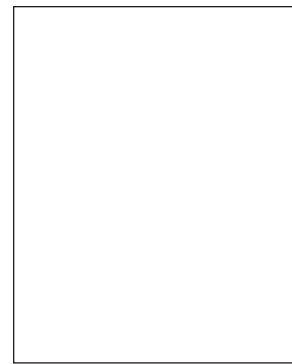


Nick Schwetz—C-Team Assistant Coach
